





Setup Steps


There are six steps to the setup process.

- Install batteries in the remote control unit
- 2 Connect the speakers
- 3 Connect the audio devices
- 4 Connect the power cable
- 5 Turn the power on
- 6 Begin playback

Installing batteries in the remote control unit



2 Connect the speakers



Connecting the speaker cables

- 1) Peel off about 10 mm of sheathing from the tip, then twist the wire core.
- 10 mm
- 2 Loosen the speaker terminal.



③ Insert the speaker cable into the speaker terminal.




4 Tighten the speaker terminal.


